
# GERMAN DUAL VOCATIONAL TRAINING 2026





#### What is an Ausbildung?

An Ausbildung combines theoretical learning with practical on-the-job training where you split your time between working in a company and attending a vocational school (Berufsschule).



**Duration: 3 Years** 

#### What Sets Ausbildung Apart from University?

An Ausbildung focuses on practical skills needed for specific professions. While university education is more academic and taught at a university, an Ausbildung prepares you directly for a career by giving you hands-on experience directly from industries and companies.

## Benefits of Ausbildung



# 1 It's Completely Free

Companies provide the vocational training completely for **free** with a goal to absorb its apprentices into the company upon completion.



## **O2** You Get Paid an Allowance

A monthly allowance of **800€ to 1500€** is provided by the company. The allowance is sufficient to support living expenses for the 3 years duration of the training in Germany. Average cost of living in Germany including rent, utilities, groceries and transportation is around 800€ a month.



# O3 Job Security upon Completion

Most apprentice are **offered full-time jobs** at their training companies after completing the training with good performance. However, you are free to work at other companies if you wish to.



# Hands on Experience

Get **direct exposure** to your chosen field from day one. Usually a mentor is assigned to you from the company to give you a deeper understanding of your role.






## Preparation Centre
